What will I learn throughout the course?

PRE-PRODUCTION

Pre-production includes screenplay writing using industry standard formatting of your script, creating shot lists, shooting schedules, inventory lists, release forms and more. These are required to plan and organise shoots for the production stage to run smoothly and are an essential phase in film and media production.

PRODUCTION

During production, you will learn to use camera fundamentals such as focus, exposure, ISO, frame composition, lenses, filters and other camera settings and techniques. Lighting setups including three-point lighting, using reflectors, diffusion and more. You will learn how to use audio field recorders, boom microphones, setting recording levels and other skills to capture sound for your screen and media projects.

POST-PRODUCTION

In Post-production, you will learn how to bring all your footage and assets together to create a final product. This includes organisation of media assets, ingestion of footage and video editing to export a final product. You will learn about delivery platforms, screen formats and codecs, naming conventions and more.
