SAFETY:

Learn the requirements to work safely in a building and construction environment including understanding Work Health & Safety (WHS) requirements and the regulations. You will identify hazards, assess risks, and understand operation procedures and gain experience in completing WHS Report Forms, using Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) and how to make sure tools and equipment are safe to use. Including NSW WHITECARD.



TOOLS, EQUIPMENT & MATERIALS:

You will learn the correct handling, use, maintenance, and storage requirements for a range of hand and power tools including compound mitre saws, sanding tools, chisels, bevels, squares, tape measures, electric planes, measuring and levelling equipment and more.

PROJECTS:

The projects will enable students to plan and prepare for each task and will include interpreting construction documentation such as sketches, plans and specification. Students will follow Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for each step referring to the appropriate safety requirements and will work as a group and individually to: plan, calculate material quantities, select and use required tools and equipment, and complete tasks on time.
