If you're a prospective student you may be able to get subsidised training for selected courses through the NSW Government program, Smart and Skilled. You can contact Smart and Skilled by visiting smartandskilled.nsw.gov.au or calling 1300 772 104.

To be eligible, you'll need to be:

- At least 15 years old
- No longer at school
- Living or working in NSW
- An Australian citizen or permanent resident, humanitarian visa holder or NZ citizen.

You may be eligible for fee exemptions in a Smart and Skilled course if you're:

- An Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander student
- A student with disability
- An Australian Government welfare recipient.

The Illawarra ITeC has on offer subsidised traineeship places for eligible new entrant trainees. These places are subsidised by the NSW Government under the Smart and Skilled initiative.

Who is eligible to undertake a Traineeship under Smart and Skilled?

Candidates must be:

- 15 years old or over
- Living or working in NSW
- An Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, Australian permanent humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen
- A new entrant trainee (employed for less than 3 months full time or 12 months part time or casual) prior to commencement of traineeship

SBAT TRAINING

GET PAID GET TRAINED GET EXPERIENCE

SCHOOL BASED APPRENTICESHIPS AND TRAINEESHIPS (SBATs) provide students with the opportunity to attain a nationally recognised Vocational Education and Training (VET) qualification. By undertaking SBAT Training a student replaces academic units for the HSC and the Traineeship forms part of their results for an ATAR. Students get paid by their employer and gain real work experience.

Who is eligible to undertake a School - Based Apprenticeship and Traineeship (SBAT)

Candidates must be:

- A full time student 15 years old or over
- Have an agreement with the student's school to undertake school based training
- Work a minimum of 8 hours per week
- Must be new entrant trainee (employed for less than 3 months full time or 12 months part time or casual) prior to commencement of traineeship

FINANCIAL INCENTIVES MAY BE AVAILABLE TO ELIGIBLE EMPLOYERS.
CONCESSIONS AND FEE EXEMPTIONS MAY APPLY TO ELIGIBLE TRAINEES.
